- President Updates - Abby Pfeiffer
 - None
- Vice-President Updates - Abby Pfeiffer
 - October 14th 4-8pm: Panera on Knoxville
 - BWW and Potbelly are future options for the coming months
 - Noodles and company: \$157.85
- Treasurer Updates - Sarah Schiffli
 - Current Balance: \$39,221
 - Slower with direct donations this year (received \$2947 of budgeted \$6550 - 61%)
 - Operations costs are a little higher due to a website subscription renewal (occurs every 3 years). Subscription changed to yearly for budgeting purposes
- Secretary Updates - Allie Tetzloff
 - Q1 Treats to be delivered this week on Thursday. There will be 430 scones for the teachers with coffee and beverages. Students will receive a rice crispy 'snap crackle and pop - thanks for being a treat this quarter!'
